IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

A rich young man walked about disappointed when Jesus told him to sell all of his possessions and give to the poor. Jesus said it is easier for a camel to fit through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to get into Heaven. This was a way to illustrate that it is hard to follow Jesus when we love our stuff, more than we love God. Matthew 19:16-26, The Rich Young Man
